- To instill an appreciation and aspirations for excellence and nurture a sense of gratitude.

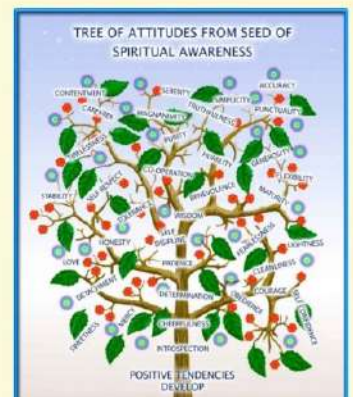
OUTCOMES
