

**FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION BETWEEN UNIVERSIDAD AUTÓNOMA
DEL PERÚ AND JAIN COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, REPUBLIC OF INDIA**

Among those signed by mister **ANTHONY JOHAN ALFARO ACUÑA**, with National Identity Document No. 41044992, and who acts in his capacity as General Manager of the **UNIVERSIDAD AUTÓNOMA DEL PERÚ**, a Private Higher Educational Institution created by Resolution No. 335-2007-CONAFU dated December 12, 2007 and with an Institutional License granted by SUNEDU through Resolution of the Board of Directors No. 083-2018-SUNEDU/CD dated July 20, 2018, with address at Carretera Panamericana Sur km 16.3 Mz. To Lt. 6, district of Villa El Salvador, Lima, Peru, on behalf of the same, according to powers granted by the Board of Directors and the University Council of Universidad Autónoma del Perú and in accordance with the powers attributed to it by the Statutes of Universidad Autónoma del Perú (Peru), who for the purposes of this document will be called **UA** on the one hand; **Dr. J SHIVAKUMAR**, acting as Principal & Director of **JAIN COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING**, with address at Tippusultan Nagar, Hunchyanatti Cross, Machhe, Belagavi, Karnataka 590014, Republic of India, a university that according to its vision, aspires to be a solution resource to the various challenges of society by promoting innovation, research and entrepreneurship through an education based on values, who for the purposes of this document will be called **JCE**, sign this cooperation agreement, taking into account the following clauses, previous these:

DECLARATIONS

UA and **JCE** are united by a community of principles, interests and objectives in the academic, cultural, research, extension and technical assistance fields, materialized in the agreement.

UA and **JCE** share the common interest of contributing to the areas of knowledge common to both institutions.


UA and **JCE** are aware of the need to join forces to strengthen teaching, research and social outreach in their respective countries.

This agreement will be governed by the following:

CLAUSES

FIRST. OBJECTIVE. The objective of this agreement is to establish the basis for cooperation between both institutions to promote processes of mutual collaboration, for the generation of knowledge and the development of academic activities in all professional and postgraduate careers offered by both institutions.

SECOND. SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES. **UA** and **JCE** undertake to develop the objective of this agreement through the following actions and activities:

- a. Carry out joint projects of an academic, cultural, and/or research nature on topics of common interest to both institutions.
- b. Promote the exchange of information, within the scope of their respective powers, whether for training, analysis, research and innovation purposes, or advice in fields of common interest to both parties and as long as there is no legal impediment for this purpose.
- c. Collaboration in professional education and training through the organization and development of courses, seminars, conferences, symposiums, exhibitions, round tables, workshops, congresses and other academic events that are of interest to the "PARTIES", whether they are of a face-to-face, virtual or remotely, observing the eligibility requirements that they have established in their respective fields of competence, or those that they mutually decide for the fulfillment of the purposes of this Agreement.
- d. Promote joint projects that encourage the continuous improvement of education, as well as the use and dissemination of its results, which contribute to the improvement and enrichment of the functions carried out by each institution.
- e. Carry out joint projects that contribute to the improvement and enrichment of the tasks carried out by each of the Institutions, and that serve to offer answers applicable to the fields of scientific and technical knowledge that are specific to the disciplines that each one dominates.
- f. The exchange of experiences in the design, administration and operation of activities to promote the entrepreneurial culture, business incubators and accelerators.
- g. Exchange of experiences in linking processes between the actors of the academy, governments and companies.
- h. Link in academic challenges.
- i. Promotion of professional exchange relationships.
- j. Any other that according to its corporate purpose and authorized activity are agreed by the parties.

PARAGRAPH: For the development of the specific objectives mentioned in this clause, Specific Agreements will be signed.

THIRD. COORDINATION. For the development of this agreement, a Coordinating Committee is constituted by:

QUARTER. FUNCTIONS OF THE COORDINATING COMMITTEE. The Coordinating Committee will fulfill the following functions:

- a. Agree on the activities to be carried out and verify the results derived from them.
- b. Render reports on the development of the agreement to the legal representatives of the institutions, suggesting its development, extension or termination.

FIFTH. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS. The Institutions will make an effort to foresee, in accordance with the budget assigned to each of them, the necessary means to put this into action and, if necessary, will request these means from organizations that promote the cooperation activities agreed upon in it.

SIXTH. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY. The parties declare that for the purposes of the ownership of the intellectual property rights caused within the specific activities and programs, on the results of the same, and even on any work that is created, its disposition, transformation, diffusion, fixation, dissemination or communication, among others, of the investigations or their results or works created for or within the development of the Agreement, the two institutions will be holders of the author's economic rights in equal proportion as long as it is the product of the contribution of each party or the results of the agreement.

SEVENTH. NO EXISTENCE OF EMPLOYMENT RELATIONSHIP. This agreement does not generate any employment relationship between UA and JCE, so teachers or administrators, students or any other type of staff that the parties assign for the execution and development of the agreement, will retain their link and employment relationship with the entity on which they depend.

EIGHTH. ASSIGNMENT OF THE AGREEMENT. Neither party may partially or fully assign the rights and obligations arising from this agreement without the express, prior and written authorization of the other party.

NINTH. GROUNDS FOR TERMINATION. The expiration of the term of duration without resorting to the extension established in this Agreement, the mutual agreement of the parties expressed in writing and with just cause, or the partial or total breach of any of them, constitute grounds for termination of this agreement.

However, and regardless of the reason for the termination, the programs, projects or activities that are being carried out at that time will continue until the scheduled date and for their respective approval.

TENTH. VALIDITY. This agreement will have a duration of five (5) years that will begin to be in force from the date of the last signature and will be automatically renewed, unless one of the parties expresses its desire to terminate this agreement, at least 30 days before the end of the current period.

ELEVENTH. DISPUTE RESOLUTION. Both parties declare that this Agreement is established in good faith and that all possible actions will be carried out for its due compliance. In the event of differences arising on the occasion of the celebration, execution, fulfillment, termination or liquidation of this agreement or regarding acts that affect or may affect the contractual relationship, the parties must go to the direct and immediate settlement with the representatives designated by the parties, obligated entities.

Having read this agreement and the parties agreeing with its content and the scope of all its clauses, this agreement is signed in two (2) copies of equal tenor and value, so that each party has an original of each one, in the cities of Belagavi, Republic of India and Lima, Perú.


